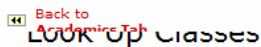


How to search for humanities or social science electives in the Banner “Look up Classes” option.

- 1) Hold the shift key and select all Subjects.
- 2) Type a 2 in the Course Number (for 2xx level classes, or 3 for 3xx level)
- 3) Select “Social Science Requirement” in the Attribute Type (and/or “Humanities Requirement”)
- 4) Click on Class Search
